Today's hand comes from Richard Ward (North) in the Pairs. EW seemed not to be confident of their system knowledge. The 1NT opening was unusual and showed 8-10 points, maybe unbalanced – as it was. Ward interposed 3C, then 3NT by East, passed back to Ward who was not done – he found 4H. This was doubled by East and might well make eight tricks – a good save against E/W's making 3NT – but no, West wasn't confident, and removed to 4D, raised to 5D by a probably infuriated East and doubled by South (Tully). On the CK lead N/S made six tricks (SA and a spade ruff, CQ and two club ruffs, and HA) for +800 – a lot better than a minus score in 4HX if East had trusted his partner and passed 4HX.
