- a) See QBA Regulations Section E Pages 1 & 2 for Standard Formats. Full details must be on entry form if format not listed among the standards.
- b) Qualifying dates for masterpoint ranks for Novice, Graded and Restricted Events must be added. See Section E Page 1. Note in particular that neither average masterpoints nor total masterpoints may be used to define the upper limit of a grade.
- c) Appropriate phrasing for QBA Events eg "Red Masterpoints at State Championship Level"
- d) QBA Championship Events require a statement as to residency status eg "The Title will be awarded only to a pair satisfying the residency restrictions of the QBA Regulations."
- e) Systems
 - a. Any combination possible for congresses. QBA recommendation is that Blue & Green Systems only be used for Novice Events and the lower/lowest section of graded events. If you want to stress that Red & Yellow Systems & Brown Sticker Conventions & Treatments will not be permitted then by all means do so.
 - b. Where yellow systems are to be permitted in a QBA Event or Congress, specify the date and/or time by which the Chairman QBA Tournament Committee or Director, as the case may be, must receive copies of any system cards and supplementary sheets, as well as the form and/or number of copies required. Also mention that failure to meet the specified deadline date may result in prohibition of some or all of the relevant methods for part of or the entire event.
- f) Your club may wish to use a different method e.g. position after the first session. Whatever the method, describe it fully. Be aware that players may expect that a field will be divided into sections of approximately the same size. Unusual methods e.g. a handful off the top and bottom with the bulk in the middle may draw criticism if not detailed on the entry form.
- g) Scoring method needs to be stated for pairs events e.g. matchpoints, butler
