- 3) Green, Blue and Red systems and Brown Sticker conventions and treatments permitted in the higher grade/s, Green and Blue systems only in the lowest grade.
- 4) Red Masterpoints awarded for each match won or drawn plus outright awards to the top 1/3 of the Field (not guaranteed unless an ABF number is provided).
- 5) Smoking is not permitted in the playing area.
- 6) Bring your own lunch.
