Eligibility

Players must individually meet the eligibility criteria to compete in events. This includes team/pair events where all players must be under the stated masterpoint range or age as per below. Overseas players may enter Novice, Restricted or Intermediate events, however they must quote their local registration number and be eligible to play in equivalent events in their own country. Grand Slam players must state their rating when entering, eligibility includes under 54% for Novice, 56% and under for Restricted, and 59% and under for Intermediate events.
